VARIABLE 3 OR 4 BECOMING NORTHERLY OR NORTHEASTERLY 5 TO
7, OCCASIONALLY GALE 8 AT FIRST. ROUGH OR VERY ROUGH.
SHOWERS, WINTRY LATER. MODERATE OR GOOD

SOUTHEAST ICELAND

NORTHERLY OR NORTHEASTERLY 6 TO GALE 8 DECREASING 4 OR 5,
OCCASIONALLY VARIABLE 3 LATER. VERY ROUGH OR HIGH
BECOMING MODERATE OR ROUGH. WINTRY SHOWERS. GOOD,
OCCASIONALLY POOR

EAST NORTHERN SECTION

IN EAST, NORTHERLY 6 TO GALE 8 BECOMING VARIABLE 3 OR 4,
THEN BECOMING SOUTHERLY OR SOUTHEASTERLY 6 TO GALE 8
LATER. VERY ROUGH OR HIGH BECOMING ROUGH OR VERY ROUGH.
SHOWERS, WINTRY IN NORTH, THEN FAIR, THEN RAIN LATER.
MODERATE OR POOR, BECOMING GOOD FOR A TIME.
IN NORTHWEST, NORTHERLY 4 OR 5, OCCASIONALLY 6 AT FIRST,
BECOMING VARIABLE 3, THEN SOUTHEASTERLY 6 TO GALE 8
LATER. MODERATE OR ROUGH, BECOMING ROUGH OR VERY ROUGH
LATER. RAIN LATER. GOOD, BECOMING MODERATE OR POOR LATER.
IN SOUTHWEST, NORTHWESTERLY 5 OR 6 BACKING WESTERLY 3 OR
4, THEN BACKING SOUTHERLY 7 TO SEVERE GALE 9, VEERING
SOUTHWESTERLY 6 LATER. ROUGH OR VERY ROUGH. RAIN FOR A

TIME, MAINLY LATER. MODERATE OR GOOD, BECOMING POOR FOR A TIME

WEST NORTHERN SECTION

IN NORTHEAST, VARIABLE 3 OR 4 BECOMING SOUTHEASTERLY 6 TO GALE 8, THEN BECOMING CYCLONIC 7 TO SEVERE GALE 9 LATER. ROUGH OR VERY ROUGH, BECOMING MODERATE FOR A TIME IN NORTH. FAIR THEN RAIN, WITH SNOW IN FAR NORTHWEST.

MODERATE OR GOOD, BECOMING POOR AT TIMES, BUT OCCASIONALLY VERY POOR IN FAR NORTHWEST. LIGHT ICING DEVELOPING LATER IN FAR NORTHWEST.

IN SOUTHWEST, SOUTHEASTERLY BECOMING CYCLONIC 6 TO GALE 8, INCREASING SEVERE GALE 9 AT TIMES. ROUGH OR VERY ROUGH. RAIN OR SNOW, BUT BECOMING MAINLY FAIR IN SOUTH. MODERATE TO VERY POOR, BECOMING MODERATE OR GOOD IN SOUTH. LIGHT ICING DEVELOPING LATER IN FAR NORTH

EAST CENTRAL SECTION

NORTHWESTERLY 6 TO GALE 8 BACKING WESTERLY 4 OR 5, THEN BACKING SOUTHERLY OR SOUTHWESTERLY 6 TO GALE 8 EXCEPT IN SOUTHEAST. VERY ROUGH OR HIGH BECOMING ROUGH OR VERY ROUGH. SQUALLY SHOWERS AT FIRST IN EAST, OTHERWISE FAIR, BUT THEN RAIN IN NORTH AND WEST. MODERATE OR POOR, OCCASIONALLY GOOD

WEST CENTRAL SECTION

IN EAST, WESTERLY 4 OR 5 BACKING SOUTHERLY OR SOUTHWESTERLY 6 TO GALE 8, OCCASIONALLY SEVERE GALE 9 IN NORTH, THEN DECREASING 5 AT TIMES LATER IN NORTH. VERY ROUGH, OCCASIONALLY ROUGH. FAIR THEN RAIN. MODERATE OR GOOD, OCCASIONALLY POOR.

IN SOUTHWEST, SOUTHERLY VEERING SOUTHWESTERLY 6 TO GALE 8, INCREASING SEVERE GALE 9 AT TIMES. ROUGH OR VERY ROUGH BECOMING VERY ROUGH OR HIGH. RAIN. MODERATE OR POOR.

IN NORTHWEST, SOUTHERLY 7 TO SEVERE GALE 9 VEERING SOUTHWESTERLY 6 TO GALE 8, THEN DECREASING 5 OR 6 LATER. VERY ROUGH, OCCASIONALLY HIGH. RAIN THEN SHOWERS. MODERATE OR POOR, OCCASIONALLY GOOD LATER

DENMARK STRAIT

VARIABLE OR CYCLONIC 3 OR 4, INCREASING 5 AT TIMES, THEN BECOMING EASTERLY OR NORTHEASTERLY 6 TO GALE 8 LATER, PERHAPS SEVERE GALE 9 LATER IN FAR SOUTH. MODERATE OR ROUGH, BUT SLIGHT OR MODERATE NEAR ICE EDGE. SNOW SHOWERS. GOOD, OCCASIONALLY VERY POOR. LIGHT OR MODERATE ICING DEVELOPING NEAR ICE EDGE IN WEST, PERHAPS SEVERE LATER IN FAR WEST, WITH TEMPERATURES MS03 TO MS06

NORTH ICELAND

NORTHERLY OR NORTHWESTERLY 5 TO 7 BECOMING VARIABLE 3 OR 4. VERY ROUGH AT FIRST IN SOUTHEAST, OTHERWISE MODERATE OR ROUGH. SNOW SHOWERS. MODERATE OR GOOD, OCCASIONALLY VERY POOR. LIGHT OR MODERATE ICING AT FIRST IN NORTH, MAINLY WITHIN 100 MILES OF ICE EDGE, WITH TEMPERATURES GENERALLY MS02 TO MS05, BUT MS06 TO MS09 NEAR ICE EDGE

NORWEGIAN BASIN

CYCLONIC 4 OR 5 AT FIRST IN SOUTHERN AND CENTRAL AREAS, OTHERWISE MAINLY NORTHWESTERLY 5 TO 7. ROUGH OR VERY ROUGH. RAIN OR SHOWERS, THEN SNOW SHOWERS. MODERATE OR GOOD, OCCASIONALLY POOR

OUTLOOK FOR FOLLOWING 24 HOURS:

VIOLENT STORMS EXPECTED IN EAST NORTHERN SECTION. STORMS EXPECTED IN BAILEY, WEST NORTHERN SECTION, WEST CENTRAL SECTION AND THE WEST OF DENMARK STRAIT. SEVERE GALES EXPECTED IN ROCKALL. GALES EXPECTED IN FAEROES, SOUTHEAST ICELAND, EAST CENTRAL SECTION, THE SOUTH OF SEA AREA NORTH ICELAND AND THE SOUTHWEST OF NORWEGIAN BASIN
